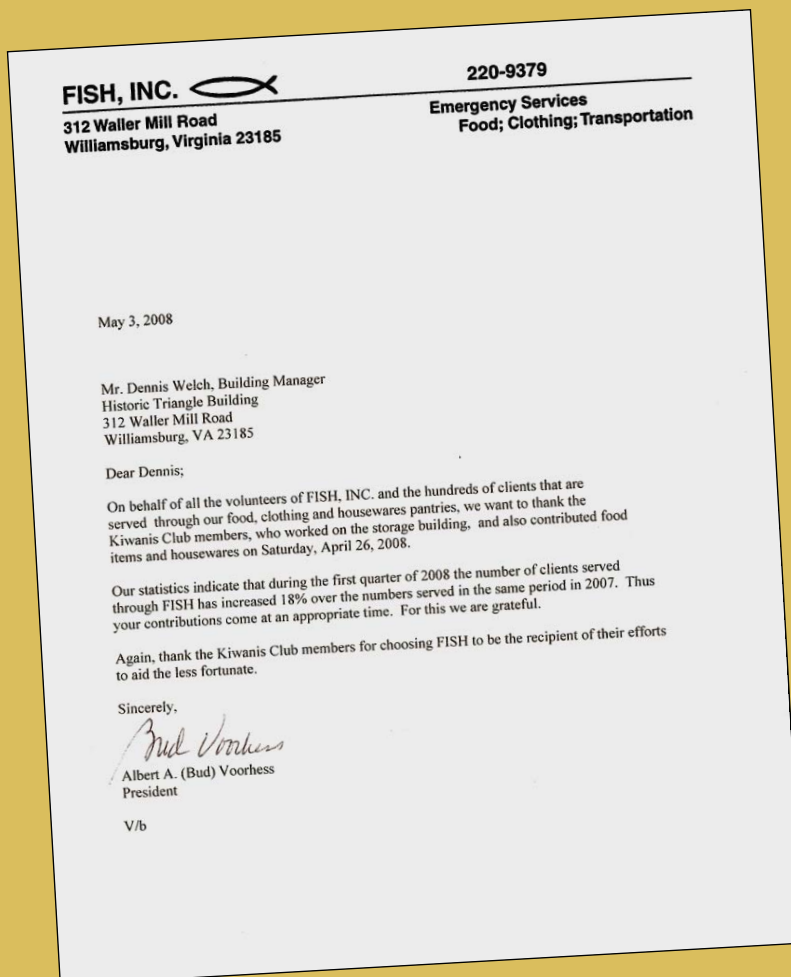
One suggestion on the club assessment was to make copies of the board meetings minutes and treasurer's reports available to the club. These

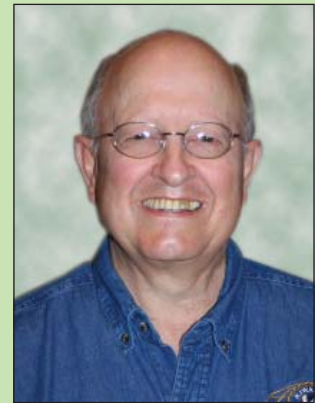
