Ticket sales are so important to the financial success of this event. Please sell the tick-

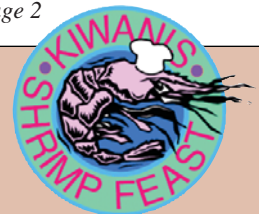

Today's Speaker: *Jacque Paul Klein*

Jacques Paul Klein received his undergraduate and graduate degrees in history from the Roosevelt University in Chicago, and has done post-graduate work in international politics at the Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C.

He entered the Foreign Service in 1971, and has served in numerous capacities throughout the world, including as Consular officer at the American Consulate General in Bremen; a political officer in the Office of Southern European Affairs for the Department of State; and Senior Advisor for International Affairs to the Secretary of the Air Force, with the Rank of Deputy Assistant Secretary.

He returned abroad in 1993 to serve in Stuttgart, Germany, eastern Slavonia, Baranja, and Western Sirmium (UNTAES), with the rank of Under-Secretary-General. In 1998, Klein became Principal Deputy High Representative for Bosnia and Herzegovina, with the personal rank of Ambassador. In August 2001, UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan announced the selection of Klein as Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Coordinator of United Nations Operations in Bosnia and Herzegovina with the

rank of Under-Secretary-General.

Klein has received many honors and awards, including the Presidential Meritorious Service Award, the Secretary of State's Career Achievement Award, the Department of State's Distinguished Honor Award,

as well as three Superior and Three Meritorious Honor awards. He also received the Secretary of Defense Medal for Outstanding Public Service, as well as the Department of Air Force's Awards for Exceptional and Meritorious Civilian Service.

He is a member of the Cosmos Club, the Army and Navy Club and the Washington Institute of Foreign Affairs. He is married to Dr. Margrete Siebert Klein and has two children, Christian and Maia, and four grandchildren.
