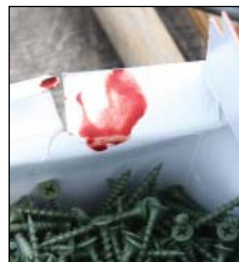

Dr. Cash is an emergency physician with Williamsburg Emergency Physicians, a position he has held since 1997. He will talk to us today about the earthquake in Haiti, and the continuing aftermath more than one year later.

Dr. Cash graduated from the MCV School of Medicine in 1982. He served his emergency medicine residency at the University of Cincinnati from 1982-1985. In addition to his present duties, he also is medical director and lead physician for the Department of Homeland Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). He also serves with the urban search and rescue team, Virginia Task Force 2, Virginia Beach Fire Department.

Members To Go Bald For St. Baldrick's, Will Help Local Girl

We need your help! We are going to shave our heads to stand in solidarity with kids being treated for cancer and to raise money for life-saving research.

We know there are a lot of worthwhile causes, but we have been touched by the story of Jesse who lives in Williamsburg and was diagnosed with neuroblastoma last November at age 2 which means she has a cancerous mass wrapped around her aorta and has already undergone surgery and chemotherapy.

Jesse is adorable, funny and very brave. She calls her IV drip "Red Fred" and says the CT scan machine looks like a doughnut. She likes hot dogs and watching "Dora the Explorer" just most kids at that age. Her hero is her mother who has to drive her an hour each way sometimes several days each week to treatments at Children's Hospital of the Kings Daughters in Norfolk.

Until about a month ago, we were not familiar with St. Baldrick's, which is the largest contributor to children's cancer research behind the U.S. government. Ten years ago, three friends decided to shave their heads to support children fighting cancer. To date, they have awarded over \$57 million in research grants. This year alone, over 37,000 volunteers are signed up to shave their heads...and now we are too!

We are calling ourselves the "Bald Businessmen." Our goal is to raise \$10,000 by May 1. If we can get 100 friends to give us \$100 each, we will meet our goal, but any amount is appreciated.
